

## Checking the Battery


#### Recommended Attachment Method

The method below is a suggestion. If you don't consider it workable for your fishing operation, then please feel free to try an alternative method.



## Place Banana Pinger every 7 nets (192 meters)

Connect pinger between net panel joins on the floatline.




Place Banana Pinger every 192m (or every 7 net panels)



Recommended joining rope is 1.8 meters of 8mm polypropolene rope.

Rope threaded through the yellow banana (A) must be LONGER than the rope passing above pinger (B).

This will ensure that the pinger is not under tension when hauling. See stage 3.



# Connect Banana Pinger between net panel joins on the floatline

Rig in such a way that hauling forces are placed through the ropes above the pinger. When hauling, the rope threaded through the pinger should not be put under tension.



Pinger allowed to move freely even when floatline is under tension.
